Introduction:

Commercial poultry in Pakistan was established in 1962. Poultry sector is one of the most vibrant segments of livestock in Pakistan. This sector provides employment (Direct / indirect) to over 1.5 million people. The current investment in Poultry Industry is Rs. 750.00 billions. Pakistan has become the 11th largest poultry producer in the world with the production of 1560 million broilers annually. Poultry industry of Pakistan is making tremendous contribution in bridging the gap between supply and demand of meat protein. Poultry today is not only a balancing force to keep check on the prices of mutton and beef, but also serving as backbone of agriculture, as it consumes 190 billion rupees worth of agriculture produce and by products of agriculture. Poultry meat contributes 40-45% of the total production in the Pakistan. This sector has a growth @ 10-12 percent annually, which reflects its inherent potential. Poultry has contributed 1.4 percent in GDP during 2016-17. The poultry value added at current factor cost has increased from Rs. 151.1 billion (2015-16) to Rs. 162.8 billion (2016-17) showing an increase of 7.7 percent compared to the same period last year. Keeping in view the importance of poultry industry, PPA in collaboration with UVAS, Lahore is organizing a Poultry Science Conference (PSC@IPEX 2018) on September 27-29, 2018.

Foreign Guest Speakers



Dr. LI Yanbing

Professor, Harbin Veterinary Research institute, China

LI Yanbing is a virologist whose research focus is the study of influenza virus and its epidemiology. She has diagnosed and confirmed most of the outbreak cases of H5 subtype highly pathogenic avian influenza in poultry and wild birds in China, fulfilled the surveillance on live poultry markets and nature reserves around the country, performed extensive basic research to understand the evolution and the genetic basis of the virulence and host range of avian influenza viruses, and selected representative isolates to be used as vaccine donor candidates. She has published over 40 papers in international peer-reviewed journals.



Dr. Muhammad Munir

Lancaster University, U.K

Dr. Muhammad Munir is a virologist with research experience on virus pathobiology, viral antagonism of immune responses and host factors that limit virus replication. His research focuses on understanding the molecular mechanisms of inter-species pathogenesis of zoonotic viruses specifically, using model influenza viruses. His research aim to explore host and viral RNA biology sensing interferon responses, epigenetics and gene regulation and define structural and functional differences in human and animals which determine the transmission dynamics of animal viruses to human.



Achille Schiavone

Associate Professor, University of Turin, Italy

Achille Schiavone is working as Associate Professor in Department of veterinary sciences in University of Turin. He has PhD in poultry production and his area of expertise are animal health, poultry nutrition and feed formulation.



Dr. Qi Xiaole

Harbin Veterinary Research Institute, China

Dr.QiXiaole is currently working in the Harbin Veterinary Institute, China and his research work on Infectious Bursal Disease (IBD) virus and his research aim to explore the immunosuppression of different viruses of poultry origin.
