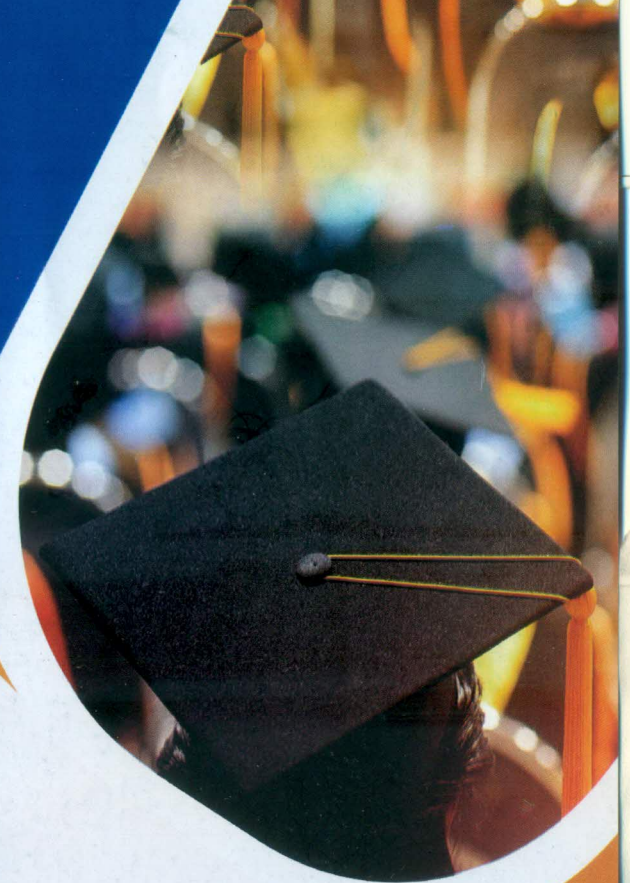

AWT's Scholarship Program

- Application Submission via respective vice chancellor/principal or relevant office
- Scrutinizing and shortlisting through due process of university/college
- Final interviews by AWT Scholarship Program Committee
- Disbursement of financial aid to selected students via university/college to student account OR adjustment of fee and hostel expenses of student directly.
