

Long Live Pakistan.



HISTORY OF UVAS

HISTORY OF UVAS

With the history of more than 135 years, University of Veterinary and Animal Sciences is one of the oldest and most prestigious Veterinary institutions of Asia. Its history dates back to 1882 when it was known as the Veterinary School and since then it is serving animal health and food safety needs for our country. Near the turn of the nineteenth century, the school was up raised to the status of Punjab Veterinary College. From there onwards, the names were changed quite often, based on the changes in the curriculum of the veterinary Eructation till 2002 when the institution was known worldwide as the College of Veterinary Sciences.


In 1954 the name of the college was changed to the Punjab College of Animal Husbandry, and title of the degree was changed to B.Sc. (A.H.) In the year 1959, the syllabus was revised and the duration of the course was increased to five years. Realizing the role of livestock in national economy, the government upgraded the College of Veterinary Sciences to University of Veterinary and Animal Sciences in 2002 with a mandate to act as a hub for generating skilled manpower in the field of veterinary sciences.



The University was also expanded and a new campus was built at Pattoki, 70km South of Lahore, where state-of-the-art animal hospital, livestock and poultry farms, fish farms, aviaries, wildlife park, feed mill and other amenities were established. The University's role in the field of education and research is not only producing qualified graduates to boost the livestock sector in Pakistan but to expand the horizon of its educational system by affiliating with other national and international universities, private sector and industries as well.
