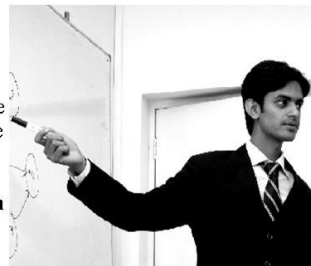

Department of Management Studies (DMS) is offering MBA (Life Sciences) degree programs in Morning and Evening. Higher education commission requires students who have 14 years of education to complete 90-96 credit hours for this degree. As per HEC road map, we are offering two years MBA (Life sciences) program consisting of 6 semesters of 16 weeks each.

The most frequently asked question by the new entrants are as follow:

### 1-Where do I get the admission application form and MBA prospectus?

Admission application form and MBA Prospectus for morning and evening program are available at DMS office.

### 2- What are admission requirements for MBA degree?

• To secure seat for MBA students must have:

- Bachelor's degree with at least second division (HEC recognized)
- LSMAT score

A satisfactory interview with the admission committee

### 3- What is the road map for application process?

office of DMS.



• Fill up the application form completely according to the instructions given in the form.

- Complete the LSMAT registration form.
- Provide 2 Reference letters
- Attach all duly attested credentials

• Attach payment evidence in the HBL, Civil Lines branch account # 01277900030303 or get a bank draft/pay order payable to "The chairman D-L-Eco& business management" for Rs.800/- (Eight Hundred Only). (Rs. 500/- for Prospectus and Rs. 300/- for LSMAT).

### 4- What is the time line for admissions process?

Event	Date
Admissions Open	Monday, 5 <sup>th</sup> July, 2010
Last Date for Form Submission	Monday, 2 <sup>nd</sup> August, 2010
LSMAT	Sunday, 8 <sup>th</sup> August, 2010
Interviews starting from	Monday, 23 <sup>rd</sup> August, 2010
Commencement of Classes	Monday, 4 <sup>th</sup> October 2010

### 5- What is LSMAT?

LSMAT is a test very similar in pattern to GMAT except English essay which will not be a part of LSMAT. There is no any preset requirement for minimum score for LSMAT.

### 6- What is the approximate fee requirement for the program?

The total fee requirements for two years MBA morning program (2010 – 2012) is approximately Rs.198, 000 and for two years MBA evening program (2010 – 2012) is Rs.208, 000.

### 7- How often DMS takes the admissions?

Once in a year; before Fall Semester

### 8- Is hostel facility available for students coming from out side Lahore?

Hostel facility is available for undergraduate students only. Very limited availability is for MBA students.

### 9- Any financial assistance available from DMS?

DMS at UVAS is a self financing department and does not offer any financial assistance to any of its students.

### 10- What is the difference between Evening and Morning MBA?

- Work experience of at least one year is required from evening applicants
- Morning students will be considered as fresh candidates.
- Fee structure is also little bit different for both programs.
- Credit hours requirements are the same for both programs according to HEC Road Map.
- Specialization tracks are similar for both programs.
