About the position

We are looking to recruit an enthusiastic ‘Project Manager’ to coordinate a research program focused on Pakistani livestock systems. This role will involve managing and undertaking research on livestock systems to advise and help improve livelihoods of smallholder farming families in rural Pakistan.

This position will incorporate research in the following areas; (1) developing and implementing extension and communication strategies, (2) investigating opportunities and constraints and developing strategies to improve on-farm efficiency in livestock production and (3) investigating and developing collaborative strategies to enhance value-chains linking smallholder livestock farmers to market opportunities.

The successful applicant will work with other academics at UVAS, Lahore and be responsible for coordinating a team of researchers working across both Pakistan and Australia. Our primary partners in Australian are from the Faculty of Veterinary and Agricultural Sciences at the University of Melbourne.

1. Selection Criteria

In order to be considered for interview by the selection panel, applicants must address all of the selection criteria in their application.

1.1. Essential

- An awarded Masters/PhD, or equivalent, in a field relevant to international value-chain research, agribusiness, social science aspects of agricultural or veterinary sciences, with at least two years’ work experience
- Demonstrated ability to manage and lead a young dynamic research team under limited supervision whilst maintaining a positive and collegiate working environment
- Excellent communication skills in English, written and oral, appropriate for scientific and industry audiences
