Animal experiments remain essential to understand the fundamental mechanisms underlying the onset, diagnosis and treatment of diseases. Rodents are used as experimental models due to their genetic, biological and behaviour characteristics, which can be extrapolated for the use in medical sciences. The protocol used for their care and handling is a critical factor for the conduct and acceptance of research trial. Keeping this in view, Department of Anatomy and Histology has planned a day-long training to introduce the participants to the ethical concerns in animal research, methods of mice handling and restraining, tissue sampling and oocyte collection. As part of the training, the participants will get hands-on training of all of the above-mentioned procedures.
