INSTRUCTIONS FOR CANDIDATES

- The examination will be conducted On-Line without campus-invigilation mode. **The candidate will send email to the Controller of examination that he/she is agreed to appear in the online PhD examination mode of assessment.**
- The Candidates may get details of course contents from the Chairmen of their Departments. Each paper may include questions from the independent studies as well as the seminars and it will be of **06** hours duration and maximum marks of each paper will be **100**.
- The examination will be designed to ascertain whether the candidates have attained the breadth of knowledge and the intellectual maturity necessary to become a successful scholar in the chosen discipline. This will not be mere re-examination of previous course(s) work but will be designed so as to test the ability to integrate and assimilate the knowledge obtained from the courses, seminars and independent studies. To pass the written comprehensive examination, a student must obtain at least **65%** marks separately in each paper.
- The candidate will remain available on Google-meet during the course of examination with Camera switched to “ON” mode. As each examiner will remained present during the course of examination as an invigilator, therefore, faculty will be awarded honorarium as an invigilator. This is to mention that this mode of assessment is **ONLY** applicable during the Lockdown phase.
- As the total duration of examination is NOT less than 6 hours, therefore, candidate is allowed to upload the split file based on number of questions. This will facilitate the student to upload the small-sized file even if internet broadband is poor. The candidate will solve the paper on answer sheet. After this, the answer book will be scanned and will be converted into PDF file. The students will mark his/her signature on every page of answer book. The candidate is requested to use Android-build-in scanner and may be converted into PDF by software (e.g., www.jpg2pdf.com). After conversion, the pdf file (s) will be uploaded to CTS system or alternatively to the email of the concerned examiner. In case of any delay due to electricity or internet failure, the student will communicate with the examiner for the problem. The examiner will guide the student that is best at the time.
