UVAS wins PPA Research Awards during Poultry Science Conference-2019



The University of Veterinary and Animal Sciences Lahore in collaboration with Pakistan Poultry Association (PPA) organized a three days Poultry Science Conference on the occasion of International Poultry Expo (IPEX-2019) at Expo Centre Lahore.

Each day's theme included Poultry Health, Farm Management and Nutrition, Processing, Value Addition and Food Safety. The organizers received more than 70 abstracts related to these themes. After technical evaluation, 21 papers were selected for oral presentation. Six keynote speakers, including five international ones

from the UK, the USA and Lebanon, attended the conference. Other oral presenters were from various universities of Pakistan. On each day three laptops were distributed among the participants on asking the best questions from the oral presenters.

Pakistan Poultry Association Research Awards of worth US\$3000 each were given to two best papers presented at the conference. The research papers were evaluated by a panel of three experts of poultry sector. The awardees were none other than Dr Jibran Hussain, Assistant Professor, Department of Poultry Production, UVAS, and Ms Afsheen

Academia-Industry joint efforts key to poultry development



The University of Veterinary and Animal Sciences organised a stakeholders' meeting on 'Academia-Industry Research Drive for Poultry Sector".

Vice-Chancellor Meritorious Prof Dr Talat Naseer Pasha chaired the meeting. Representatives of poultry industry, the Pakistan Poultry Association, stakeholders from public and private organisations including Mr Khalil Sattar. Dr Abdul Kareem Bhatti, Ch Muhammad Furgham, Ch Muhammad Nusrat Tahir and a number of academicians, researchers and professionals attended. Prof Pasha said that UVAS was focusing on problem-solving research, rural entrepreneurship and food safety. He gave a detailed presentation on the contribution of UVAS in poultry sector. He spoke about UVAS future plan on consumer awareness, disease control, market interventions, poultry processing

and value edition, halal certification for export and improvement in rural poultry. Dr Paul D Ebner, a professor of animal sciences from Purdue University, spoke about development & commercialization of antibiotic alternatives for poultry production in Pakistan.

The participants called for starting a campaign through social and electronic media for consumer education, removing any ambiguity/concern about the use of steroids, hormones and antibiotics in poultry and its feed. They said that joint efforts are needed by academia and industry for development of poultry industry. They suggested that it is direly needed to establish a committee for conducting market-based research, collecting data regarding per capita income and saving, demand and behaviour of consumer, marketing forecast and financial analysis.

MoU inked for research on dairy animal monitoring



The University of Veterinary and Animal Sciences Lahore and Cloud Agri Pakistan signed a memorandum of understanding to collaborate on research in dairy animal monitoring through sensor technologies. Director Office of Research Innovation and Commercialization Dr Farhan Jamil and General Manager Cloud Agri Pakistan Dr Muhammad Asad Ullah Khan signed the MoU. According to the MOU, both parties

will work in dairy production with primary focus on the monitoring of buffalo behaviour for estrus detection, onset of calving time and early detection of health events, etc. The UVAS would provide its technical support to develop standard behavioral indicators. The behavioral monitoring devices will be used at UVAS for research purposes and will serve as a mean of demonstration for livestock producers..

CUVAS signs MoU to improve habitat of migratory birds, wildlife

The Cholistan University of Veterinary and Animal Sciences Bahawalpur and Houbara Foundation International Pakistan (HFIP) signed a memorandum of understanding to improve the habitat and conservation status of migratory birds and wildlife through trail research studies of in-situ and ex-situ conservation practices at CUVAS Bahawalpur. CUVAS Vice-Chancellor Meritorious Prof Dr Talat Naseer Pasha (SI) and President Houbara Foundation International Pakistan (HFIP) Brig (Retd) Mukhtar Ahmad signed the MoU. Pro Vice-Chancellor Prof Dr Masood Rabbani, Director External Linkages Dr Imtiaz Rabbani and officials from HFIP were present. Speaking on the occasion, Prof Pasha said that students, faculty members and researchers would get maximum benefits from the availability of wild animals, disease diagnostics laboratories at CUVAS. According to the MOU, HFIP will facilitate CUVAS for



sampling (blood, fecal etc.) of captive animals kept at different facilities. HFIP will assist in capturing/ trapping of animals like reptiles (lizards and snakes), birds and small mammals (rodents and hare) within the captivity for research purpose. HFIP will also facilitate the internees/researchers in movement and stay at research centers/protection posts in Cholistan desert. CUVAS Bahawalpur will provide health and diagnostic facilities including laboratory tests, surgery and postmortem with recommendations.

CUVAS will assist in monitoring population status of migratory birds and other wildlife at Cholistan desert. CUVAS would conduct research on concerned species and share the results and recommendations for improvement of the status of that species.
