

**Event Report for the Photographic Tour  
“Photowalk to Katas Raj Temples & Kalar Kahar”

Still & Film Society in association with TAMRON lenses PAKISTAN  
held on 11<sup>th</sup> November 2018**

**The Still and Film Society Lahore**, in association with **Tamron lenses Pakistan**, organized a one day Photographic Study Tour to “Katas Raj Temples and Kalar Kahar”. University of Veterinary and Animal Sciences provided us with a 52 seat capacity bus however the POL was given by the students. A ticket of PKR 1699/- was fixed which covered the expenses of Breakfast, Lunch, Refreshments, Sky Lanterns, Fuel Expenses and Bus Service Charges as well as motorway toll taxes for all the students.

45 students registered for this event and joined in the event. Dr. Saadat Ali, Assistant Professor from the IBBT was the faculty advisor for this tour.

The bus left the outdoor at sharp 08:30 AM. Breakfast was given at Bhera interchange. Then we reached Katas Raj Temples after breakfast. Students took photographs of the temples along with group photos. Then we left for Kalar Kahar. Refreshments were given in the way. However the bus met an accident with a vehicle and faced damage to the front, back, right side and one of the rear tires burst but the bus was in control and the students faced no injury.

After reaching Kalar Kahar, dinner was served at TDCP Kalar Kahar. Tea was served after the dinner. Then we launched sky lanterns at the bank of Kalar Kahar Lake and then we headed back towards Lahore via Grand Trunk Road or National Highway Number 5. We reached city campus a little late because of the detour of GT road, as the shortcut road was under construction and that road was unsafe for the bus.

Application for the hostel girls entry was given to the girls hostel warden. The faculty advisor, Dr. Saadat Ali accompanied the girls for entrance into the hostels. The bus was refueled with a full tank and parked into the university. It was altogether an amazing event but due to some detours, road problems and the accident, the schedule was disturbed.

In the end, all the students were happy and enjoyed a lot. We hope to arrange more trips but without any problems.
