### ADVISORY ON PRECAUTIONS AGAINST THE SPREAD OF HUMAN METAPNEUMOVIRUS (HMPV)

In view of the global spread of Human Metapneumovirus (HMPV) and its potential risks, particularly through international travel, it is imperative to implement precautionary measures.
